

American Defenders of Bataan and Corregidor Memorial Society Scholarship Application

The ADBC-MS is now accepting scholarship applications for the Fall 2018 school year. Recipients must be a descendant of a person who was a Prisoner of War of the Japanese during WWII. A maximum of three scholarships in the amount of \$1000 each will be awarded. Applicants must currently be high school seniors or in the first, second or third year of college. In addition to the application, two additional documents are required: a letter describing the applicants' course of study and educational goals, and an essay about the POW relative including information about his/her experiences during the war and their POW captivity.

Applications and all materials must be received by May 31, 2018. Applicants will be notified of decisions after June 30, 2018. Scholarships will be paid upon receipt of proof of matriculation in an accredited post secondary technical school or college.
